

Sew Spoiled Designs
Boxy Wristlet with detachable Key Fob

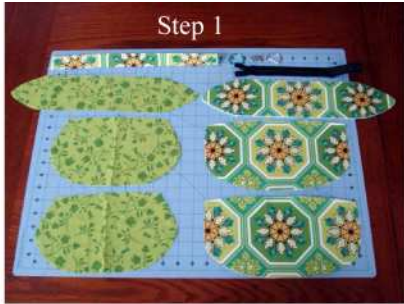


Sew Quick, Sew Easy,
Sew Spoiled

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Step 13: Separate the layers, pin the exterior panels together **right sides together** and the interior panels together **right sides together**. Just pin the sides of wristlet approximately 1". (Diagram 13a-b) Make sure that the zipper is lined up and you have pinned the small loop under the zipper for the key fob handle. Stitch one inch on either side of the wristlet. Sewing over the small loop on one side(Diagram 13b-c) At the zipper pivot your needle so you are able to continue at a 1/4" seam allowance.



Step 14: Mark the center of the wristlet "floor". Open the bottom of the outer shell panels and pin from the center up to the side stitches. (Diagram 14a-b)





Step 15: This is a sneak peak of the wristlet floor after being pinned on. (Diagram 15a) Pin the lining floor on too the same way. Start at the center and move up to the stitching on either side. (Diagram 15b)



Step 16: Sew the lining first it is great practice for the rest of your project and if you make a mistake no one will ever see it. :) Stitch where you pinned. (Diagram 16a) Make sure that you leave a hole in one side, you will have to stitch the hole side like you pinned (center up). (Diagram 16b) The other lining side sew from side stitch to side stitch. Make sure that the wristlet floor is flat as you sew. (Diagram 16c) Crisscross when you get to the side stitches. (Diagram 16d)





Step 17: Sew the outer shell from side stitch to side stitch 1/4" seam allowance. (Diagram 17a-d) Don't worry about any excess from the wristlet floor you can always trim it later.



Step 18: Trim the sides and curves. (Diagram 18a) Flip the wristlet right side out by putting your hand inside and grabbing the outer shell. Iron the wristlet so it looks like the end result you want. Also iron the lining closed.

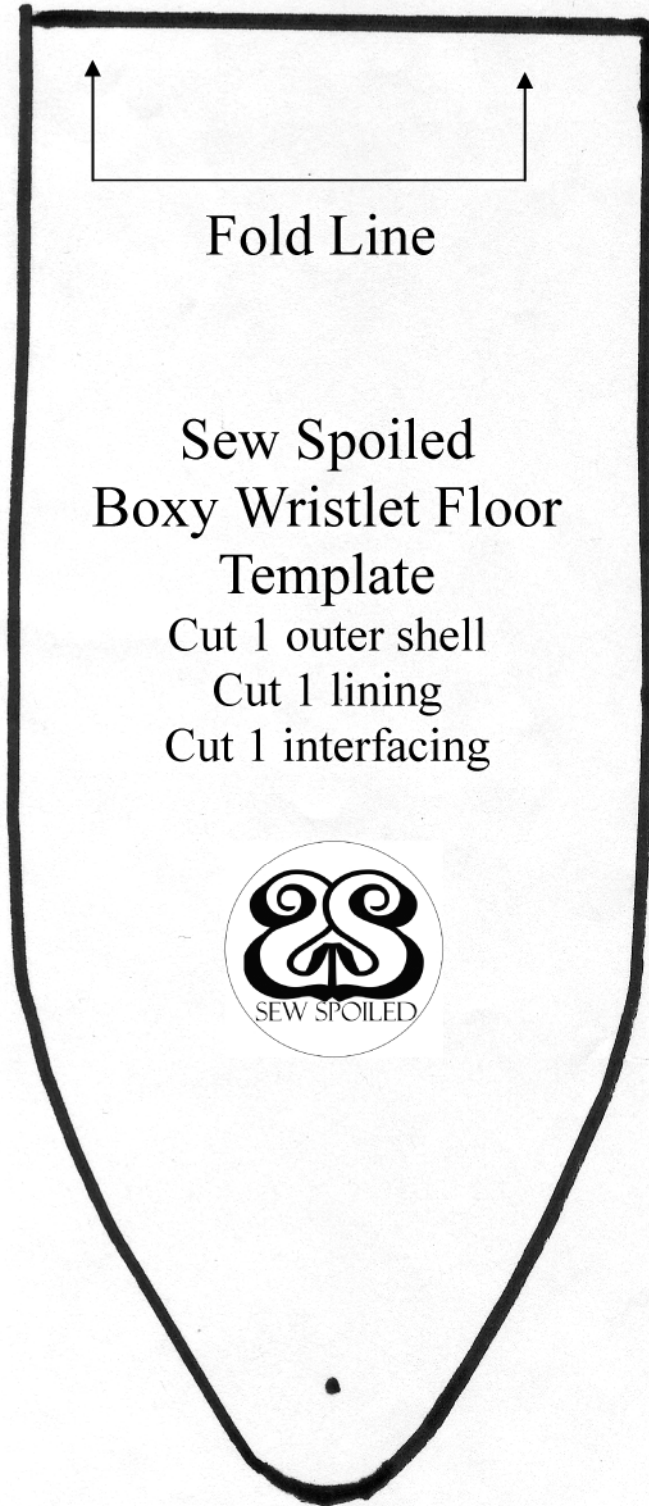




Step 19: Sew the lining closed!!! And tuck it back inside!!
You are done with your Sew Spoiled Boxy Wristlet!!!
(Clip the key fob on.)
