

Print on 8.5" x 11" white card stock.
For best results use 110 lb., bright white.

1. Cut around outer edge of coffin and the inner coffin panel.
Using an X-acto knife cut 2 small slits in Flap A on dotted lines.
* Try using a black felt marker to color the white edges of the paper.



2. Printed side down, score each fold.
Use a ball point pen or small ball burnisher and a ruler. Align ruler and burnish an indentation where the paper should fold.
* If you can't tell where to score when the printed side is down just turn it printed side up and use a pin or X-acto blade tip to poke a couple of holes on the fold line. Turn the paper white side up and use the holes as a guide.

3. Apply glue, using a toothpick, to each tab. Fold sides together to create coffin.
* Old fashioned hair clips (the straight kind) are great for holding parts together while the glue dries.

4. Glue inner coffin panel to the inside of the coffin lid.

5. Fill with candy to create a spooky treat all your little goblins will love.
