Instructions and artwork to create your own **HOLIDAY GIFT TAGS.**

These playful Gift Tags are a great way to dress up your gifts. 6 designs to choose from.

Before you get started, please read through all of the instructions.

Materials List:

-Heavy-weight paper stock of your choice

Tools Needed:

- -Craft knife or Scissors
- -Metal ruler
- -Cutting mat
- -Hole-punch

Step 1.

DOWNLOAD THE IMAGE TO YOUR COMPUTER

Step 2.

OPEN WITH SOFTWARE THAT SUPPORTS THE PDF FORMAT

A. You can open and print your image from Adobe® Reader®. To download Adobe® Reader® go to www.adobe.com.

Step 3.

PRINT OUT THE DESIGN

A. Print out the image on a heavy-weight paper stock of your choice.

Step 4.

CUT OUT THE DESIGN

A. Trim out around the edges using a sharp craft knife or scissors. If using a craft knife, be sure to use a good cutting surface like a self healing mat.

Step 5.

PUNCH A HOLE THROUGH THE CUT DESIGN

A. Use a single hole-punch to put a hole through the design.

B. Tie Gift Tag onto packages with ribbon or string.
