Halloween Banner



You will need:

- 1) 4 sheets of white or light-colored cardstock
- 2) 7 segments of ribbon (3 pairs, 1 for the middle) about 16" long and thin enough to thread through the hole of a hole punch.
- 3) a hole punch (small hole)
- 4) scissors
- 5) a long ribbon, string or wire, to act like a clothesline (optional)

Assembly Directions:

From a home inkjet printer or color lazer printer, print pages 2–5 of this PDF file on 8.5X11" cardstock.

Cut out designs. You can leave them as-is or go the extra mile, adding glitter or pom-poms.

Using a hole punch, make a hole about 1/4" away from the top center of each circle.

Cut ribbon to desired lengths. Steps 5 thru 8 explain how to attach it to the circles.


Thread both ends of a piece of ribbon through a circle (from behind).




Pull through the hole to the front side of the paper circle. 7)


Follow back through the top loop of the ribbon.

Pull until loop is snug against the bottom.









Tie the top portion of the ribbon to its desired place on the long string, to hang like a clotheline. You can make a bow or a simple tie. Each piece can also be hung individually, tied to a stair railing or hooks on a mantlepiece. Be creative.
